Notes

The document, on light blue paper, is a contract for a 6 month lease of some land. The phrase about the rent has been altered to sixty pounds, by means of crossings out; both parties have initialled the margin.

John F R Stainer would marry Ruth Mallam some decades later. It is interesting to note a Randall - Mallam connection in earlier times.
